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«Execution of works on reconstruction and modernization street lighting networks in Bila Tserkva city on replacement obsolete fixtures with new LED ones, replacement of brackets, arrangement of protective grounding of electric supports, disposal of dismantled lamps and adjustment of design documentation»

Department of Housing and Communal Services of Bila Tserkva City Council, hereinafter referred to as "the Employer", intends to use part of the proceeds of a loan from the Nordic Environment Finance Corporation (NEFCO) towards the (cost) of Project: Reconstruction and modernization street lighting networks in Bila Tserkva city by technical re-equipment.

The Employer now invites the Contractors to submit their tenders for the following contract to be funded by the loan, aimed at purchase of: "Execution of works on reconstruction and modernization street lighting networks in Bila Tserkva city on replacement obsolete fixtures with new LED ones, replacement of brackets, arrangement of protective grounding of electric supports, disposal of dismantled lamps and adjustment of design documentation".

To be qualified for the award of a Contract, Tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

- the Tenderer, has the financial, technical, production and capability and capacity necessary to perform the Contract. Tenderer demonstrates revenues for each of the last three years and average annual revenue in the previous **three** (3) years was at least **two** (2) times greater than price of his tender. In case of tender submitted by JVCA, the leading partner should demonstrate at least 50% compliance with the requirement;
- the Tenderer has satisfactorily delivered similar plant and works to other Employers and completed at least **five** (5) Contracts with similar scope and cost (the cost of similar contract must be not less than 3 million UAH) in the recent **five** years;
- the Tenderer or its agent will be able to carry out warranty obligations;
- the Tenderer is not bankrupt or under bankruptcy procedures according to the national legislation or regulations; in the case of a Tenderer offering to deliver plant under the Contract which the Tenderer does not manufacture or otherwise produce, the Tenderer has been duly authorized by the plant's manufacturer or producer to deliver the plants in the Employer's country.

In preparation of their offers, the Tenderer should take into account that the works in this Contract will tentatively start on **September 2020** and continue to **February 2021**.

Tender documents, upon request from prospective Tenderer, will be sent by email free of charge in electronic format (PDF file). If requested to send documents in the written form, the documents will be sent by Employer to Tenderer on terms and conditions agreed by the two.

All Tenders must be accompanied by a Tender security in the form of tender-securing declaration whose form is provided in Tender Document. The purpose of Tender security is to ensure the Tenderers are serious about their participation.

Tenders must be delivered to the office at the address below before 24.07.2020 at 10:00 a.m. at which time they will be opened in the presence of those Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend.

Pre-tender meeting of Tenderers with the Employer's representatives for visiting the project sites and discussion of technical and logistical issues will be held on a third week from date of tender announcement in the period of tender proposals preparation individually by prior agreement through official correspondence.
